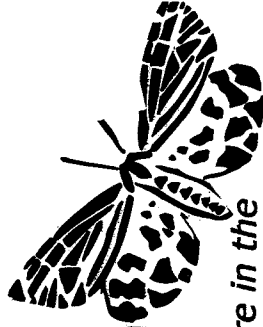


Episcopal Church Women's News Bulletin



Fall is here! And so is a very busy time of year for the ECW! We are in the midst of one of our fund raisers – the casserole sale – and making preparations for another – our annual Marketplace. We hope you will read on and find out how you can get involved!

But first, we are beginning a book study! We will meet at the church on the first and third Tuesdays beginning October 6th at 7 pm. **Everyone is invited to attend.** There will be a facilitator who will pose some questions and everyone will have a chance to participate in the discussion. Our first book will be *The Jesus I Never Knew* by Philip Yancey. Yancey reveals the real Jesus beyond the stereotypes, offering a new perspective on his life and work – and ultimately who he was and why he came. He presents a complex character who wants to radically transform your life and stretch your faith.

We will be taking orders for 450 so it takes a lot of help from you! If you want to help but do not want to cook, you can donate money that we will use to make casseroles.

Once you have made and frozen your casseroles, you may bring them to the church on either the 5th or 12th of October. There will be a list in the kitchen for you to mark your casseroles off when you leave them.
